Preseason Sports/Activities General Meeting and Individual Team Meeting Plan
Tuesday, August 9, 2016 @ AHS @ 7 PM
Grades 7-12



ONLINE REGISTRATION IS OPEN: Annandale Middle School (AMS) and Annandale High School (AHS) students are encouraged to register for sports and activities online. Registration can be completed on the "Athletics/Activities" tab (<http://www.annandale.k12.mn.us/athletics-activities>) on the school website. In less than 10 minutes, the MSHSL form and online payment for sports/activities fee can be completed - registration is now open. First day for fall high school sports is Mon., Aug. 15 for high school sports and Mon., Aug. 29 for middle school sports/activities.

NEW THIS YEAR – Once-per-School Year General Meeting with the Activities Director: The format for this year's preseason meeting plan (listed below) is different from previous years. Prior to the school year, there will be a once-per-school year general meeting with the activities director for all AMS and AHS students (and their parents/guardians) that plan to participate in a sport or activity during the 2016-17 school year (regardless of the season in which the sports/activity takes place: fall, winter, or spring).

- **What:** Annandale Public Schools Preseason Sports/Activities Meeting
- **When/Where:** Tues, Aug 9, 2016 at 7 PM in the AHS Auditorium
- **Who:** For any AMS and AHS student (and parent(s)/guardian(s)) that plans to participate in a sport or activity during the 2016-17 school year
- **Why:** Gather key details/information specific to extracurricular activities
- **AMS and AHS individual team breakout meetings:**
 - **Fall Sports/Activities (cross country, volleyball, football, girls' tennis, and fall play) - individual team breakout meetings for Fall Sports/Activities ONLY to immediately follow the general meeting on Tues, Aug 9**
 - **Winter and Spring Sports/Activities – exact date/time of individual team meetings: TBD (will be scheduled at a date/time closer to the beginning of the season start date for each sport/activity)**

It is very important that all fall coaches/advisors (head and assistant, grades 7-12) are present at this meeting, so that parents have an opportunity to meet the coaches/advisors that will be working with their sons and/or daughters and for coaches/advisors to disseminate key info/details regarding the upcoming season. Sports/Activities Registration Items

The following registration items need to be completed, prior to being eligible to participate in practice/competition (this info can also be found on the Athletics/Activities" webpage:

1. Complete the online MSHSL form and emergency information (only once per year). Click on the "Online MSHSL Eligibility Form" link below to complete the forms (should take about 5 minutes). [Online MSHSL Eligibility Form](#)

*Upon request, there are hard copies of these forms available in the High School Office if you would prefer to fill it out by hand.

2. Pay your activity fee through Parent Portal (or by bringing in a check/cash to the HS Office).

*Sport/Activity Fees for 2016-2017:

Athletic Fees - Grades 9-12: \$150 per Sport

Athletic Fees - Grades 7-8: \$125 per Sport

Activity Fee - Grades 9-12: \$85 per Activity

Activity Fee - Grades 7-8: \$72 per Activity

*Price Caps:

Individual Student Cap - Grades 9-12: \$300

Individual Student Cap - Grades 7-8: \$250

Family Cap: \$500

3. For athletics, make sure you have a current sports physical on file in the High School Office. (They are good for three years)

*7th and 10th grade athletes (or any athlete who does not have a physical on file) - **you will need a sports physical**. Print the 2016-2017 Sports Physical Form from the athletics link under "Sports Physical Form". Bring it with to your sports physical. Once completed with your physician, you can drop them off at the HS or MS office, at the Back to School Day (which will be at the Annandale Elementary School on Tues, Aug 9), drop them off at the AHS activities office during the summer office hours (Wednesdays from 8 AM-Noon), or mail to Wendy Storkamp, PO Box 190 Annandale High School, Annandale, MN 55302).
